



At this point, how certain are you about what your course grade will be?



Which of the following factors influenced you to take this course (select all that apply)?




On average, the number of out-of-class hours per week I spend in study and preparation for this class






It made me realize how much really goes into foreign policy and made me gain a new respect for people in that line of work.

I can now observe foreign policy actions around the world with much more familiarity and understanding.



Great professor, passionate about course and students, his passion comes across in his lessons.


I think Professor Gold was very knowledgeable about the course material and organized very informative exercises. I think some more structured lecture would have been helpful early in the year.




